The Greater Raritan Workforce Development Board is looking for interested employers to help provide paid work experiences/internships for 60 young people in Hunterdon and Somerset counties.

The Greater Raritan Workforce Development Board SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM DETAILS:

- DURATION:** Any eight-week period between June 6 and October 14, 2022.
- AGE:** Candidates must be between the ages of 16 and 24 and can be in school or out of school.
- REQUIREMENTS:** Youth accepted into the program will work 25 hours per week: 21 hours at their job site and additional 4 hours per week doing two different virtual career-readiness programs led by the Greater Raritan Workforce Development Board.

EMPLOYERS:

Any employer in Hunterdon and Somerset counties with available part-time positions can apply to be part of the project. The work experience/internship opportunities can be in any sector in the two counties, from office or web support to recreational or nonprofit work.

Employers will receive the full stipend to pay each intern.
