

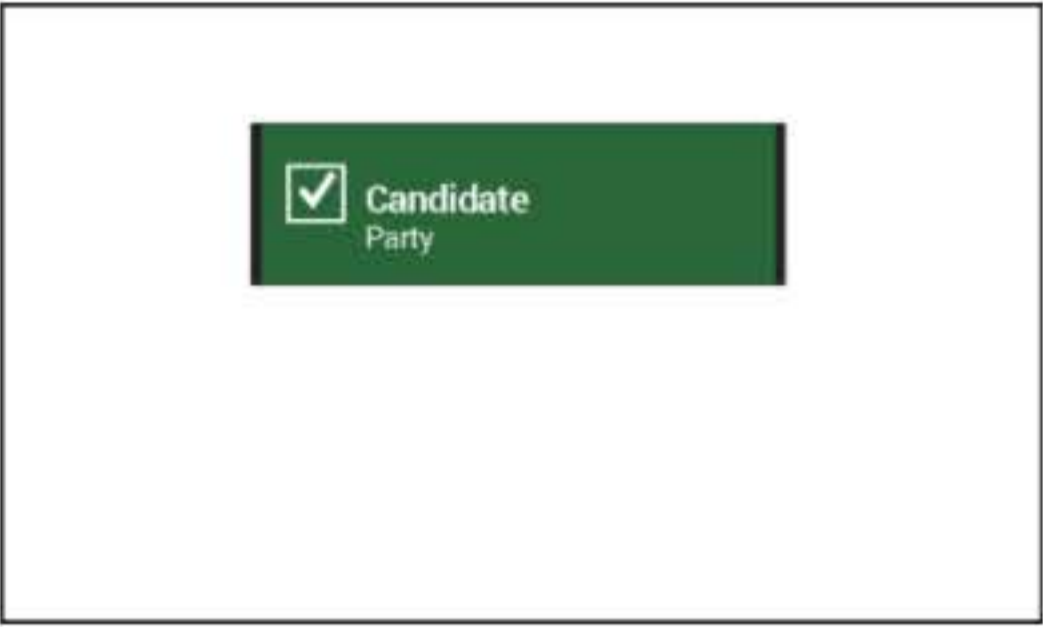
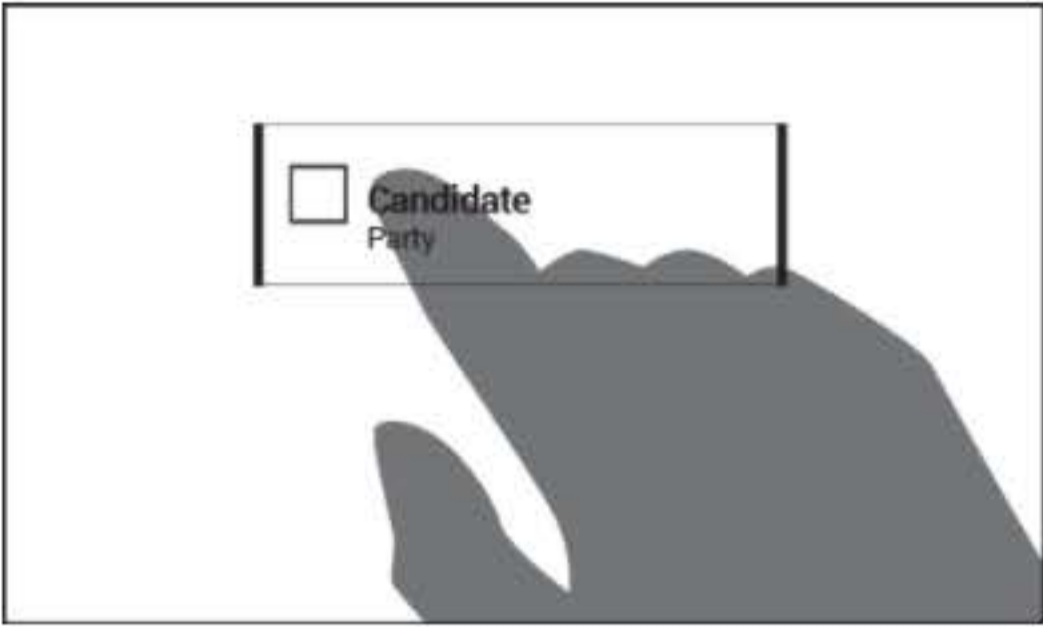

BOND PROPOSAL QUESTION

The Board of Education of the Township of Clinton in the County of Hunterdon, New Jersey is authorized (a) to undertake various improvements, alterations, renovations, and upgrades to the HVAC system at Round Valley School, and to undertake various improvements, alterations, renovations, and upgrades to the HVAC system, and to replace various windows at Patrick McGaheeran School, including acquisition and installation of fixtures, equipment and any site work; (b) to appropriate \$1,536,321 for such improvements; and (c) to issue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$1,536,321.

The final eligible costs for the projects approved by the New Jersey Commissioner of Education are \$1,536,321 (consisting of \$687,800 for Round Valley School and \$848,521 for Patrick McGaheeran School). The projects include \$0 for school facility construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). The State debt service aid percentage will equal 40% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the projects. The Board of Education is authorized to transfer funds among the projects approved at this special election.
