- a. REA Grant approved Rebecca stated that the REA Grant from the State DEP was finally approved.

Extra garbage tote will have a cost. Receive stickers for 4x a year for bulky items. Last pick up 30 tons with CJ disposal curbside to reduced 18 tons for first LMR pick up using totes. They plan to inspect the recycling. It will not be taken and will receive a sticker.

Walter Baumgarten asked about the ongoing appeal for the Concrete plant in Bethlehem Township. No new news on that site. Could it potentially be made into a Transfer Station? Rebecca Lunger commented that it is not zoned for that and probably could not be made into that.
